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Boise County Facilities Survey

“Snapshot in Time”

It is important to remember that the results presented here represent a “snapshot in time” ~ a compilation of feelings and opinions of 846 respondents for the period from June 28th through July 20th only. If the survey were taken again, the results might be different due to changes in political climate and personal experience since the original survey period.

Respondent demographics (area of residence) closely matches the 2000 U.S. Census.

5. Offering direction for County Commissioners and other elected officials for long-range facility planning.




Boise County Facts

“Boise County is ranked 34th out of Idaho’s 44 counties in population and is the 15th largest in area. In 1991, Boise County had a population of 3,805 and in 2001 that number increased to 7,011. The increase of 3,206 individuals, or 84.3 percent, over the decade makes Boise County the fastest growing county in Southwest Idaho. Boise County has increased its population, but has not received an equal gain in economic benefit as a result of commuters residing in the area while choosing to work and shop in Ada County.”




Boise County Population Growth




DEMOGRAPHICS: Number of Years Lived In or Owned Property In Boise County


DEMOGRAPHICS: Respondent ZIP Code


DEMOGRAPHICS: Registered to Vote In Boise County




Visited or Contacted a BC Facility *Personal and/or Telephone Contact*






Which Facility is Visited Most Often?






Amount of Time to Conduct Business

Telephone Contact with Boise County Offices




Have Contacted a BC Facility by Phone


Overall Telephone Service



Contrast Opinions About Boise County Issues

QUESTION: Are there any services you would like to see offered by Boise County that the County does not currently provide?

“I would like to see the county adopt an aggressive public nuisance zoning ordinance to prohibit junk yards and abandoned trash on privately owned lands. The county would also have to fund removal of such junk. Ideally the property owners would be billed for this nuisance abatement; however, some owner’s will have no assets and the county will have to pick up the tab. I would like to see a functioning county jail facility located in this county. It is foolish to pay for transport costs and pay “rent” to another county’s facility.” 🏠

“Would like to see more Boise County Sheriff presence in the Garden Valley/Crouch area. Would like to see Boise Co. establish some sort of animal shelter.” 🏠 ***Garden Valley • Employed***

“Some sort of junk clean-up policy.” 🏠 ***Horseshoe Bend • Not Employed***

QUESTION: Are there any services you would like to see offered by Boise County that the County does not currently provide?

“I would like to see the county pursue a 9-hole golf course in Idaho City. Having the rodeo there in August will bring in business. However a golf course would increase the number of summer cabins and reduce the vacant ground. This in turn would increase county revenue. Idaho City could be a very attractive location with proper management. No reason to compete with Tamarack.” 🌲 *Other Area • Employed*

“Internet access to Planning and Zoning information.” 🌲 *Garden Valley • Not Employed*

“More weed control. County road is lined with thistle and spreading fast even in the city of Horseshoe Bend.” 🌲 *Horseshoe Bend • Retired*

QUESTION: Are there any services you would like to see offered by Boise County that the County does not currently provide?

“I know I answered a question regarding this issue but it is such an important item I need to reiterate it. Our County really needs on-line services to provide the public with information. Many times we need the information and the County workers are out to lunch or it is after hours. If we were able to access this information without the need to bother a County worker it will allow the County to have more time to do other necessary things and be much more productive with their time.” 🏠 *SE Boise County • Employed*

“Boise County needs building codes. Structures need to be held to standards so they are safe.” 🏠 *Idaho City • Employed*

“To apply for unemployment or food stamps you have to attend a 2 to 3 hour class which is given in the early morning. If such a meeting is mandatory, then I feel that we should have something set up in Idaho City for such meetings, like once or twice per month for people who cannot get down there for meetings.” 🏠 *Idaho City • Employed*

QUESTION: Are there any services you would like to see offered by Boise County that the County does not currently provide?

“My priority is that the County re-open our existing jail facilities to provide for the ability to house arrestees for a minimum of one to two nights when needed. This is all that would be needed for DUI arrests during the busy summer tourist season. As well for domestic abuse, and assaults requiring a "cool off" period for offending parties. Without this ability, local law enforcement have no real tangible way to sanction, or arrest violators in the community!” 🌲 *Other Area • Employed*

“Maintenance on Harris Creek road from Horseshoe Bend to Star Ranch is bad and traffic is up. The loggers done a much better job over the years.” 🌲 *Horseshoe Bend • Employed*

“I think that the Sheriff's Department should establish and staff a sub-station in Crouch. They have been offered a space at no cost, but have declined because of the cost of communication equipment. I am sure that the current population, tax base and rate of growth in Garden Valley warrant this improvement.” 🌲 *Garden Valley • Employed*

QUESTION: Any Other Comments?

“Boise City residents, who own recreational property in Boise County, pay just as much in property taxes (given property of equal value) as Boise County residents but receive very, very few Boise County benefits. It must be great for Boise County residents to vote for higher property taxes for greater benefits (like schools and education) that only benefit Boise County residents. Then, have a large share of the cost passed on to non-residents who live elsewhere but pay property taxes on their recreational property in Boise County. Non-residents can't even vote on the issues in Boise County. (I thought the American Revolution was largely about taxation without representation.) Please tell me...what percent of the property taxes in Boise County are paid by non-residents who cannot even vote on any Boise County issue? 🏠 Other Area • Retired

“I think the county does a great job generally considering the tax base vs. the physical size of the county.” 🏠 SE Boise County • Employed

QUESTION: Any Other Comments?

“By and large, I’m very happy with the services BC provides, and the efficient way in which they do it. I like the historic buildings that currently house most County offices. With the population of BC ever increasing, the day may come when new facilities MUST be constructed. That seems inevitable despite my fond wish for things stay the same. And, of course, I’d really like to see the County offices stay in Idaho City!” 🏡 *Idaho City • Employed*

“I do not support putting any more money into the “historic” buildings in Idaho City where the county offices are now. We need a new facility that is modern and more centrally located.” 🏡 *Horseshoe Bend • Employed*

“I would like developers to pay impact fees to cover all the cost increases to the county and the current residents to cover the current services to us. I would also like to see property taxes capped at 1% of the assessed value and taxes to be due in March and September rather than June and December.” 🏡 *Horseshoe Bend • Employed*

QUESTION: Any Other Comments?

“I believe the present facilities in Idaho City are fine for daily County administration. I do feel that residents in Garden Valley have to travel the farthest to get license plates, permits, information etc. An annex in Garden Valley would be very helpful to the residents. It seems strange that the area with the highest population in the County has the least amount of services available!” 🏠 *Other Area • Not Employed*

“Consideration should be given to renovating existing facilities or expansion. Create a grant committee (if one does not already exist) to aggressively pursue any available grants for services to assist Boise County financially.” 🏠 *Idaho City • Employed*

“My taxes are high enough! The only thing I can say is that the road dept. does a very fine job and I am very grateful for their hard work.” 🏠 *SE Boise County • Employed*
