ROW APPROACH

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1. No Construction after November 1st.
- 2. Application fee to be paid to Boise County before permit will be issued. Schedule of fees shall be the latest adopted by Boise County Board of Commissioners on file with the County Clerk.
- 3. Approaches shall be for the bona fide purpose of securing access and not for the purpose of parking, conducting business, or servicing vehicles on the public right-of-way.
- 4. Location of road approach shall have a line of sight a minimum of 200 feet or greater in both directions.
- 5. No revisions or additions shall be made to an approach or its appurtenances on the public right-of-way without the written permission of Boise County.
- 6. The Permitee shall furnish all material, labor, and equipment involved in the construction of the approach and its appurtenances. This shall include furnishing approved drainage pipe of a size specified on permit curb and gutter, concrete sidewalk, etc., where required. Materials and workmanship shall be good quality and are subject to inspection and approval by Boise County.
- 7. Boise County reserves the right to require the Permitee, its successors and assigns, at any time, to make such changes, additions, repairs and relocations to any approach or its appurtenances within the public right-of-way as may be necessary to permit the relocation, reconstruction, widening, drainage, and maintenance of the roadway and/to provide proper protection to life and property on or adjacent to the roadway.
- 8. Approaches shall conform to the plans made a part of this permit. <u>Adequate drawings or sketches shall be included</u> showing the design, materials, construction requirements and proposed location of the approach.
- 9. During the construction of the approach (es), such barricades, signs and other traffic control devices shall be erected and maintained by the Permitee, as may be deemed necessary by Boise County. Said devices shall conform to the current issue on the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
- 10. In accepting this permit, the Permitee, its successors and assigns, agrees to hold Boise County harmless from any liability caused by the installation, construction maintenance or operation of the approach (es).
- 11. If the work done under this permit interferes in any way with the drainage of the roadway, the Permitee shall wholly and at his own expense make such provision as Boise County may direct to take care of said drainage problem.
- 12. Upon completion of said work herein contemplated, all rubbish and debris shall be immediately removed and the roadway and roadside shall be left neat and presentable to the satisfaction of Boise County.
- 13. Neither the acceptance of this permit nor anything herein contained shall be construed as a waiver by the Permitee of any rights given by the constitution or laws of the State of Idaho or of the United States.
