RESOLUTION #2011-02

A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A MORATORIUM FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE WILDLAND URBAN INTERFACE ORDINANCE 2010-03

WHEREAS, Chapter 5, Section IV(2) of the Wildland Urban Interface Ordinance 2010-03 requires an inspection prior to issuing building permits; and

WHEREAS, such inspections are not feasible or allowable during the winter months with the heavy snowfall; and

WHEREAS, building permit applications are continuing to be applied for during the winter months when the Planning and Zoning Department cannot process the applications due to the restraints of the Wildland Urban Interface Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 67-6523 allows the Boise County Board of Commissioners to adopt a moratorium, not to exceed one hundred, eighty-two (182) days, if such Commission finds that an imminent peril to the public health, safety or welfare exists with the enforcement of the current ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Boise County Board of Commissioners finds that refusing to issue building permits, which could be for the construction of an individual's home or place of shelter during the winter months, would cause imminent peril to the public health, safety or welfare of Boise County residents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that there shall be a moratorium on the Wildland Urban Interface Ordinance 2010-03 for a period of one hundred, twenty (120) days upon passage of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Wildland Urban Interface Ordinance requirements shall not be imposed against any pending building permit applications.




