A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION TO SURPLUS THE 1972 MOBILE OFFICE TRAILER LOCATED AT THE WARM SPRINGS COLLECTION SITE

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Department has a 1972, 10' x 36' mobile office trailer located at the Warm Springs Collection Site; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Department recently constructed a permanent building at the Warm Springs Collection Site which now houses all personnel; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Department has determined that the mobile office trailer is no longer needed at the Warm Springs Collection Site and further that they have no further need of it in any aspect of their operation; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-808 and 829 authorizes the Boise County Board of Commissioners to dispose of equipment and goods which are deemed no longer necessary to the operation of the County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Boise County Board of Commissioners approves the surplus of the 1972, 10' x 36' mobile office trailer located at the Warm Springs Collection Site.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the 1972 mobile office trailer shall be sold by sealed bid to the public and that the minimum bid accepted shall be \$500.


