WHEREAS, review and discussion of the current policy has been held by the Boise County Board of Commissioners during a regularly scheduled meeting; and


WHEREAS, an agreement has been reached on the verbiage and direction contained in this revised policy;

APPROVED and ADOPTED; this 18th of March, 2014 in Open Session of the Boise County Board of Commissioners.



Boise County Solid Waste Cleanup Event Policy

All proposed Cleanup Events, which desire the waiver of Solid Waste fees or opening a transfer station on a day other than those normally scheduled, must make application to the Boise County Solid Waste Department. The Boise County Solid Waste Department Head will review the application and may approve, approve with conditions or deny the waiver of fees or opening of a Transfer Station other than normally scheduled days and times. Cleanup Events which will not unduly impact the Boise County Solid Waste sites and do not desire fee waivers or unscheduled opening of transfer stations do not need to make application other than to notify the Solid Waste Department of the date of the planned event.

1. Solid waste collected and transported to Boise County Solid Waste Transfer Stations shall comply with Boise County Ordinance 2008-02. Solid waste fees and disposal requirements are published on the Boise County website.

2. Cleanup events which desire waiver of fees or unscheduled opening of a Solid Waste site shall:

a. Be sponsored by an incorporated city or civic organization (Chamber of Commerce, Historical Society, Homeowners Association) with a coordinator.

b. Have a defined cleanup area. Solid waste, from outside the designated cleanup area, is subject to fees allowed by Boise County Resolution 2014-29.

c. Have a single date. It is encouraged that cleanup events coincide with normally open days and hours of the transfer station. Times or days of week, outside normal published hours, require specific approval of the Boise County Solid Waste Department Head to open the transfer station without collection of "After Hours" rate fees.

d. Submit a written cleanup event proposal (not less than 30 days prior to the event) to the Boise County Solid Waste Department outlining the proposed day, time, estimated volume of waste, types of waste, who will be hauling waste and the area of cleanup, along with any requests for waiver of fees. Fees are collected per Boise County Resolution 2014-29. Fees for tire disposal will **not** be waived. A copy of the written proposal will be forwarded to the Boise County Board of Commissioners by the Solid Waste Department.

3. A written response will be provided, to the event coordinator, at least 15 days prior to the scheduled cleanup event, with a copy to the Boise County Board of Commissioners. The Boise County Solid Waste Department Head may approve, approve with conditions or deny Boise County's participation in proposed cleanup event, the opening of transfer stations and (or) waiver of fees.
