AN EAST BOISE COUNTY AMBULANCE DISTRICT RESOLUTION INCREASING THE FY2020 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the FY 2020 budget, for the East Boise County Ambulance District (EBCAD) budget, was adopted by the Governing Board of EBCAD on August 27th, 2019 via Resolution 2019-04; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 31-1605 allows the Board of County Commissioners to adjust the budget, as adopted, to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenue, grants, or donations from federal, state or local governments or private sources, provided that there shall be no increase in anticipated property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the East Boise County Ambulance District, will receive unanticipated revenues, and incur unanticipated expenses associated with the State of Idaho, Bureau of EMS and Preparedness, FY2019 EMS III Dedicated Equipment Grant, to purchase 25 EMS Education books, in the amount of \$3,125.00; and

WHEREAS, the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustment and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the FY 2020 budget, for the East Boise County Ambulance District be increased as follows:
