A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION INCREASING THE BOISE COUNTY EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS 911 FUND FY 2020 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the FY 2020 budget, for the Boise County Emergency Communications 911 Fund, was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on August 27th, 2019 via Boise County Resolution 2019-45; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 31-1605 allows the Board of County Commissioners to adjust the budget, as adopted, to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenue, grants, or donations from federal, state or local governments or private sources, provided that there shall be no increase in anticipated property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Communications 911 Fund will receive unanticipated revenues, and incur unanticipated expenses associated with the Idaho Office of Emergency Management, 2020 IPSCC Grant, award #2020-0275-1, to purchase new computer stations for Boise County Dispatch, in the amount of \$17,471.75; and

WHEREAS, the annual budget has been complied with, in making the said adjustments, and the budget adjustments shall not result in increased property taxes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the FY 2020 budget for the Boise County Emergency Communications 911 Fund be adjusted as follows:
