A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION ADOPTING BOISE COUNTY COVID-19 POLICY

WHEREAS, COVID-19 cases are increasing within Boise County at this time; and

WHEREAS, there has been COVID-19 positive tests within the Boise County employee population; and

WHEREAS, neighboring counties, particularly Ada County, now have community spread of COVID-19, and many Boise County residents rely upon essential services provided within Ada County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Boise County Commissioners held an emergency meeting on July 14, 2020, at 2:45 p.m., to address the current status of COVID-19 within Boise County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Boise County Commissioners took action at the emergency meeting of July 14, 2020, to establish COVID-19 Policy for Boise County employees and patrons, as documented within Addendum A herein.

APPROVED and ADOPTED this 21st day of July, 2020, in Open Session of the Boise County Board of County Commissioners.

ADDENDUM A

The following policies were established in the Boise County Board of Commissioners, Emergency Meeting, of July 14, 2020, through a unanimous vote:

1. All Boise County employees will be tested for COVID-19, on Tuesday July 21st or the earliest available date that a testing organization can accommodate testing in Idaho City and Horseshoe Bend.
2. Effective July 15, 2020, all Boise County employees are required to wear a face mask or face shield while in a Boise County facility.
 - a. Boise County employees within the Dispatch Department are exceptions to this section of the Policy.
 - b. Elected Officials/Department Heads are provided discretion in applying this policy and should take into account social distancing recommendation of 6 feet and interactions with other employees and the public.
3. Effective July 15, 2020, all members of the public must wear a face mask or face shield, while in a Boise County facility.
4. Effective July 15, 2020, all Boise County business is to be conducted via appointment only, with the exception of the Department of Motor Vehicles operations in Idaho City and Horseshoe Bend locations.
5. An employee wishing to self-quarantine, absent a COVID-19 positive test result, will be required to present documentation from the Central District Health Department or a medical professional, pursuant to Federal and State guidelines.

The undersigned hereby acknowledges receipt of Boise County COVID-19 Policy during my employment.

Further, it is agreed, as an employee I will be in compliance with the rules that are lined out within the Policy, unless the Policy Resolution is amended or rescinded by the Board of Commissioners.

I understand articles of this agreement apply, regardless of who is on the Board of County Commissioners.

I understand I am required to get tested for the COVID-19 virus at the Counties expense, and I am subject to wearing a facial mask, or shield, in accordance with the Policy.

I have read and agree to the provisions of this COVID-19 Resolution and requirements of this Policy.
