RESOLUTION #2020-56

A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION AMENDING THE BOISE COUNTY JUSTICE FUND, SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT, FY2020 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the FY 2020 budget, for the Boise County Justice Fund, Sheriff's and General Operations Departments, was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on August 27th, 2019, via Resolution 2019-45; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Section 63-805(2) allows the Board of County Commissioners to make a "general reserve appropriation", not to exceed five percent (5%) of the county justice fund budget as finally adopted; and

WHEREAS, the cost of inmate medical expense, has exceeded the amended appropriated budget amount and Boise County is statutorily required to pay for inmate medical expense; and

WHEREAS, the liability insurance deductible account has an appropriated budget amount covering one incident and three incidents of liability insurance claims for vehicle damage have been sustained in FY2020; and,

WHEREAS, Boise County is contractually obligated to pay deductibles for claims against the liability insurance coverage; and

WHEREAS, the funds from the Justice Fund, Justice General Reserve appropriation, need to be transferred to the Justice Fund, Sheriff's Department, expense budget; and

WHEREAS, the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustment and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the FY 2020 budget for the Boise County Justice Fund, Sheriff's Department, be increased as follows:




