**OFFICIAL MEETING MINUTES**

**IN ATTENDANCE:** Commissioner Twilegar, Commissioner Holmes, Clerk Prisco, Deputy Clerk Coffelt, Prosecutor Strong, Assessor Juszczak, Sheriff Turner, Community Justice Administrator Leader, Road & Bridge Interim Superintendent Dill, Wildland Fire Mitigation Forester Richardson, Solid Waste/Noxious Weeds Superintendent Rekow.

**ABSENT:** Chairman Stirm.

Acting Chairman Twilegar called the meeting to order and the pledge of allegiance was recited.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:** Commissioner Twilegar MOTIONED to move into executive session, to include Prosecuting Attorney Strong per I.C. 74-206(1)(i), risk management, in order to discuss any issues and obtain updates on ongoing matters falling under the motioned executive session codes. Commissioner Holmes SECONDED. Roll call vote: Commissioner Twilegar – Aye; Commissioner Holmes - Aye. Motion passed unanimously. Commissioner Twilegar brought the meeting out of executive session per I.C. 74-206(1)(i) risk management, no action required.

**CONSTITUENT INPUT:** Mr. Bud Paine spoke to the Board concerning the issues he sees with EBCAD. Mr. Gary McClean from Wilderness Ranch spoke to the Board concerning medical services in Boise County. Mr. Sam Bonovich presented documents to the Board and discussed the medical services in the County.

**MINUTES:** Commissioner Twilegar MOTIONED to accept the official meeting minutes from Tuesday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021 as written. Commissioner Holmes SECONDED; All Ayes.

**DEPARTMENTAL ISSUES:** The bid award for the Robie Creek Paving project was discussed by the Board. Commissioner Twilegar MOTIONED to approve (award) the bid submitted by Knife River, subject to them entering into a contract with Boise County in the amount of \$172,000. Commissioner Holmes SECONDED; All Ayes. It was stated on record that Trevor Howard with Horrocks Engineering recommended this bid (Knife River) for the project after looking the bids over. Wildland Fire Mitigation Forester Richardson presented documentation concerning a filming permit that is being requested for the Boise County Court House, discussion ensued. Commissioner Twilegar MOTIONED to approve the application for filming in the court house by Past Prime Productions, Richard Martin. Commissioner Holmes SECONDED; All Ayes. Ms. Richardson let the Board know that she has been contacted about setting up a COVID vaccine trailer in Horseshoe Bend. Road & Bridge Interim Superintendent Dill presented documents to the Board on a purchase request of a lowboy trailer, discussion ensued. This matter has been tabled until next week. Mr. Dill also updated the Board on the work for water resource rights and the plan to prepare Robie Creek Road for the paving project to begin. Solid Waste/Noxious Weeds Superintendent Rekow let the Board know that one of his employees resigned and would like to discuss with the Board taking two (2) part time positions and turning them into one (1) full time position. Community Justice Administrator Leader asked the Board if
