OFFICIAL MEETING MINUTES

IN ATTENDANCE: Chairman Stirm, Commissioner Twilegar, Commissioner Holmes, Clerk Prisco, Deputy Clerk Coffelt, Prosecutor Strong, Assessor Juszczak, Sheriff Turner, Interim Road & Bridge Superintendent Dill, Community Justice Administrator Leader, Emergency Manager/Forester Richardson, Planning & Zoning Administrator Gross, Solid Waste/Noxious Weeds Superintendent Rekow.

Chairman Stirm called the meeting to order and the pledge of allegiance was recited.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Not needed at this time.

RECOGNITION OF SERVICE FOR DEPUTY HASTIE: The Board of Commissioners thanked Deputy Hastie for his years of service to the Boise County Sheriffs' office, which included School Resource Officer, Dispatcher and Sheriff's Deputy.

CONSTITUENT INPUT: Mr. Steve Moore spoke about his concerns with the meeting minutes for two Board meetings in July, whereby the official meeting minutes did not include discussions regarding the possibility of East Boise County Ambulance District covering ambulance services in the Horseshoe Bend area.

MINUTES: Chairman Stirm MOTIONED to accept the official meeting minutes from Tuesday, July 27th, 2021 as written. Commissioner Twilegar SECONDED; All Ayes.

DEPARTMENTAL ISSUES: Ms. Raeleen Welton and the Board discussed a possible land swap Solid Waste/Noxious Weeds Superintendent continued the discussion concerning a possible radio repeater installment at the Warm Springs transfer station. A discussion concerning an increase of Solid Waste fees ensued between Mr. Rekow and the Board. Community Justice Administrator Leader informed the Board of suicide prevention literature that she had received and would like to post around the County. Clerk Prisco asked permission from the Board to also put the Suicide Hotline numbers on the County website, which the Board was agreeable to. Interim Road & Bridge Superintendent Dill updated the Board concerning the roads within Boise County.
