**IDAHO FEDERAL LANDS ACCESS PROGRAM (FLAP) GRANT APPROVAL:** A proposal for grant money which will include Boise County, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and Idaho Lands Access Program was presented to the Board for review and discussion. It encompasses the replacement of the Boise Street Bridge in Horseshoe Bend over the Payette River, as well as: two (2) bike lanes, Payette River Greenbelt, planning study to improve Riparian/Wetland/Raptor habitat, off highway vehicle ADA rest area & parking lot, and adjacent skate/splash/volleyball/pickle ball park, discussion ensued. Mayor Goff of Horseshoe Bend was called to confirm and get on the record information that was given to the Board. Commissioner Twilegar MOTIONED to approve the application for the 2021 Idaho Federal Lands Access Program joint endorsement; project name is Boise County Payette River Project, and the Federal land agency is BLM (Bureau Land Management). Chairman Stirm SECONDED; All Ayes.

Commissioner Twilegar adjourned the meeting until the regular meeting of Tuesday, February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.
