RESOLUTION #2023-04

A BOISE COUNTY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PROJECT APPLICATION FOR FUNDING FOR THE BANKS-LOWMAN ROAD PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Boise County Commissioners ("Board") is required to lay out, maintain, control, and manage public roads and bridges within the County under Idaho Code 31-805; and

WHEREAS, the Board is empowered to exercise general supervision over all highways in the county highway system, including their reconstruction, repair and maintenance under Idaho Code 40-604(1); and

WHEREAS, the Board is authorized to make agreements with the State of Idaho, or the United States, its agencies, departments, bureaus, boards, or any government owned corporation, for the construction, reconstruction, or maintenance of the county's highway system by those entities, under Idaho Code 40-604(6); and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-602 entrusts the Board with conducting all aspects of county business within the boundaries of law; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-801 grants the Board in their respective counties all jurisdiction and authority within the legal confines of their statutory office; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-828 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to perform all other acts and things required by law, not otherwise articulated within Idaho Code "which may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the board—as chief executive authority of the county government;" and

WHEREAS, the Banks-Lowman Road is a major arterial route that is essential to the public transportation network in Boise County; and

WHEREAS, the Banks-Lowman Road requires routine maintenance to reduce life-cycle costs of the roadway and maintain a safe traveling surface; and

WHEREAS, the Banks-Lowman Road project will cost approximately \$2,000,000 and the County is required to provide a match of \$146,800 in addition to being potentially responsible for cost overruns; and

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Board approves and signs this project application, and submits it to the Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC) for approval and prioritization.
