

RESOLUTION #97-29

A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE BOISE COUNTY FY 96-97 BUDGET TO REFLECT THE RECEIPT OF UNSCHEDULED REVENUE TO CURRENT EXPENSE

WHEREAS; Boise County Sheriff's office has received unanticipated funds from State and Federal governments and private sources for fire protection services during the 8th Street fire; and

WHEREAS; Idaho Code §31-1605 allows the Board of County Commissioners to adjust the budget to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenue from State and Federal governments and private agencies; and

WHEREAS; the annual budget procedure has been complied with in making the said adjustment, and the budget adjustment shall not result in increased property taxes;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; that the amount of \$6,045.00, monies received for fire protection on the 8th Street fire, be placed into the Boise County Sheriff's "B" budget for FY 1996-97, and expended for normal operations of the Sheriff's department.




